THE CRANMORE CURRICULUM 2023–2024

At Cranmore we are passionate about rounded education. We offer a wide curriculum focusing on the development of children in the whole, promoting personal development, academic excellence and fostering individual talents.

Pupils at Cranmore enjoy an impressive range of extracurricular activities in outstanding facilities. The list is long and varied and continually reviewed to reflect current trends. From Year 1 pupils may have individual music tuition with expert peripatetic teachers. Before and after school care is available for families who require extended care.

PREP CURRICULUM

Reception to Year 3 Curriculum

Our aim is to build an excellent foundation and foster a positive attitude towards learning for all pupils. Core subjects are taught by class teachers with opportunities for more challenging or guided work to ensure that all pupils achieve their potential. Science and humanities are taught through varied and engaging topic based learning looking at local communities and global ones, past and present. ICT is integral to the curriculum with a dedicated ICT suite for Prep pupils. Tablets and virtual reality headsets are also available in class to enhance understanding.

Children benefit from immersed experiences through external trips and visiting experts. Specialist staff teach Sport, Music and French providing children with the best opportunity to learn from professionals in these subjects. All year groups enjoy the great outdoors when they visit our Forest School.

Years 4 to 6 Curriculum

Subject specialists are predominantly used to teach from Year 4. In Science, the subjects of Biology, Chemistry and Physics are taught separately from Year 6.

All students follow a compulsory curriculum of core GCSE examination subjects and non-examination subjects, together with three options.

Options are chosen from a list of twelve further subjects:
