HOW TO APPLY

Candidates are invited to attend a group workshop followed by an individual audition. For the audition each candidate should select one piece that we will supply, and prepare it for performance. During the audition, candidates should be prepared to be directed.

Candidates who have experience in Musical Theatre are welcome to prepare a 1-2 minute verse and chorus of a Musical Theatre number which will be performed after their Drama audition. Candidates are welcome to email a musical accompaniment in the form of an MP3 link. Each candidate should submit a written record of examination taken (if any) and, production involvement both inside and outside school.
